## **Resolution of CESI ‘Post and Telecoms’ Trade Council on financial services in postal companies**

CESI’s ‘Post and Telecoms’ trade council demands that the European institutions, national governments and employers take measures that ensure that all segments of the population have access to financial services, independently of their place of residence and capacity for digital tasks.

It is possible to finance a successful network of branches with full coverage of the territory, thus ensuring that all segments of the population have access to the services.

Especially in the day and age of increasing digitalisation in all parts of life it is important to guarantee that full access to traditional financial services provided by postal companies be supported and promoted.
